#### **Watts Bridge requires that users of the airfield's facilities be members of Watts Bridge Memorial Airfield Inc.**

To attend the BVSAC monthly meeting on a regular basis you will also need to be a financial member of Watts Bridge Memorial Airfield. WBMA financial members contribute (by way of their annual membership fees) to all of the airfield's facilities. The most obvious are the airfield's runways, taxiways and aircraft parking areas. Other infrastructure includes the internal roads, sewerage system and toilets, camping and parking areas, various hangar, chalet and clubroom sites, fuel depot, buildings and shelter areas, fire fighting and safety equipment, etc. Then there is the ongoing general maintenance such as mowing the field and improvements to the airfield. In addition, there are many fees and charges levied by government agencies which need to be paid.
