



CTAF 127.30 MHz

Ground 127.90 MHz

1. The Gathering of Eagles will be held at Watts Bridge Memorial Airfield on Saturday 19th & Sunday 20th August 2017.
2. A FIR NOTAM will be issued about the event.
3. Inbound aircraft are to use normal CTAF radio procedures on **127.3 MHz**.
4. A reminder that all circuits at Watts Bridge are contra as per ERSA. See attached
5. A "WATTS UNICOM" service will be provided on 127.3 MHz. This service will provide information on air display activity, parking and other information as required. Note that this is not a control service and a clearance to taxi, takeoff and land will NOT be given.

UNICOM operating hours:

Saturday 19 August 0900 – 1700

Sunday 20 August 0900 – 1600

6. Air display practice may occur 1600 – 1700 on Friday 18 August. Pilots should plan to arrive before this period, however aircraft arriving during the practice period may be requested to hold at 5nm until the airspace is cleared for arrival.
7. Please plan to not arrive or depart during the following air display periods.
Saturday 19th August 1600 – 1700
8. **Aircraft Day Park** areas are provided to the western and eastern area of the main parking areas in front of the clubhouses. After landing aircraft should contact ground on 127.90 MHz and seek parking instructions. Pilots must observe the follow me vehicle or marshals.
9. **Aircraft Camping Park** encourages under-wing camping and is available to the western end of the airfield as shown. Note Aircraft Camping Park rules. See attached.
Normal camping fees apply, \$20 per site per night.
10. A gold coin donation will be requested from Aircraft Day Parking Pilots and passengers on arrival who are not staying for the evening.
11. AVGAS is available at the airfield and can be paid by credit card.#

Camping Rules for Under-wing

1. Fee \$20.00 per night per site. Payment is made at the air show entry point. For early arrivals, fees will be collected at the campsite.
2. Camp sites cannot be pre booked, first in first served.
3. Toilets with nighttime lighting are provided.
4. Limited shower facilities are available.
5. Cooking facilities are not provided.
6. Campers should use torch lighting when walking around at night, young children should not be allowed from the camp site area unless supervised.
7. Fires not permitted in any aircraft camping area.
8. Private portable generators are not permitted overnight between the hours of 7.00 pm and 7.00 am.
9. Aircraft pilots and passengers wishing to camp overnight may camp under the wing of there aircraft. Site fee's still apply.
10. Camping tickets should be tied to the tent or aircraft and be clearly displayed.
11. Loud and unruly behaviour will not be tolerated and please respect the privacy of fellow campers.
12. Campers are encouraged to join Watts Bridge Members for an enjoyable evening by the bonfire, taking in some stories, live music, and great food. Evening event starts 1730 on Saturday.

LOCAL TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

1. Right hand circuits RWY 12R and 30R.
2. CONTRA CIRCUITS IN OPERATION ON RWYs 12/30
THERE IS NO DEAD SIDE WITH CONTRA CIRCUITS.
3. Join circuit on downwind, base or final in accordance with published circuit join procedures.

CTAF 127.3**NOISE ABATEMENT PROCEDURES**

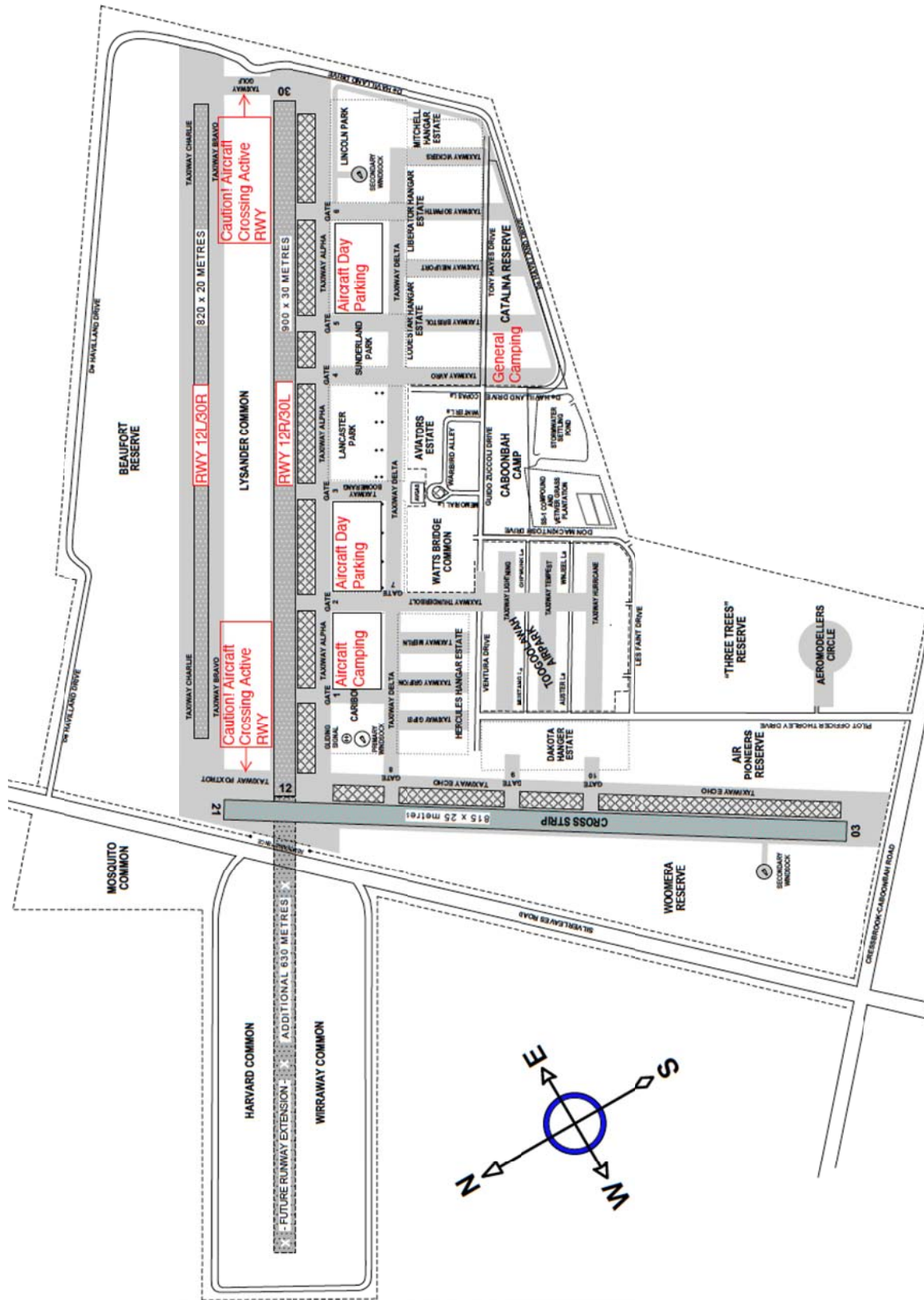
1. Pilots are to operate aircraft with minimum audible and visual impact on the local community.
2. Circuits or local airwork not permitted before 0700 Local.
3. High noise aircraft departing RWY 30L recommended right turn at 500FT.
4. Avoid low level flight over houses.
5. Consult www.wattsbridge.com.au for Fly Neighbourly information.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

1. Undershoot area to RWY 12 R is not in use and marked with white cross markers.
2. Displaced threshold exists on both RWY 21 and RWY 12R.
3. Access to RWY 12L and 30R at RWY ends only.
4. Non radio equipped aircraft may operate from the airfield.
5. Drainage ditches flank each TWY. Taxi on mown SFC and exit TWY to parking areas by marked access points only.
6. Low level aerobatic operations take place up to 5,000FT in the designated aerobatic box located SE of the airfield. Refer Watts Bridge Fly Neighbourly Map.
7. Intensive skydiving at Toogoolawah, 5NM NW of Watts Bridge.
